- Any other Bachelor's Degree from a recognized University in a relevant field, as judged by the Faculty and approved by the Senate and a minimum of **one (01) year** post-qualifying relevant experience in the area of Environmental Planning and Urban Development as judged by the Faculty and approved by the Senate.
- Any recognized category of membership of a recognized Professional Institute in a relevant field obtained through an academic route as judged by the relevant Faculty and approved by the Senate and a minimum of **one (01) year** post-qualifying relevant experience in the area of Environmental Planning and Urban Development as judged by the Faculty and approved by the Senate.
