**ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR MASTER OF SCIENCE IN ELECTRICAL ENGINEERING,
MASTER OF SMART POWER SYSTEMS**

1. Degree of Bachelor of Science of Engineering of the University of Moratuwa in Electrical Engineering; OR
2. Any other Engineering Degree of at least four years duration in a relevant field of specialization, as may be approved by the Senate; OR
3. Any recognized category of membership of a recognized Professional Institute, obtained through an academic route, with a minimum of one year of post qualifying experience obtained after the membership, as approved by the Senate.

**ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR MASTER OF SCIENCE IN ELECTRICAL INSTALLATIONS,
MASTER OF BUILDING ELECTRICAL SYSTEMS**

1. The Degree of Bachelor of Science of Engineering of the University of Moratuwa specializing in Electrical Engineering ; OR
2. The Degree of Bachelor of Science of Engineering of the University of Moratuwa specializing in Mechanical/ Electronics/ Computer Engineering with a minimum period of one year Electrical Engineering post-qualifying experience, as approved by the Senate; OR
3. Any other Engineering Degree of at least four years duration, from a recognized University, in a relevant field, as may be approved by the Senate; OR
4. Any recognized category of membership of a recognized Professional Institute, obtained through an academic route, with a minimum of one year of recognized appropriate experience obtained after the membership, as may be approved by the Senate.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR MASTER OF SCIENCE IN INDUSTRIAL AUTOMATION, MASTER OF INTELLIGENT AND AUTOMATION SYSTEMS

1. The Degree of Bachelor of the Science of Engineering of the University of Moratuwa specializing in Electrical/Mechanical/Electronics/Computer Engineering; or
2. Any other engineering degree of at least four years duration, from a recognised University, in a relevant field as may be approved by the Senate; or
3. Any Bachelor of Engineering Technology degree of at least four years duration, from a recognised University, in a relevant field as may be approved by the Senate; or
4. A degree in Engineering, Technology or Science of at least three years duration from a recognized university in a relevant field of specialization with a minimum of one year of recognized appropriate experience obtained after the degree AND a Postgraduate Certificate in Industrial Automation or in an equivalent field, as may be approved by the Senate; or
5. Any recognized category of membership of a recognized Professional Institute, obtained through an academic route, with a minimum of one year of recognized appropriate experience obtained after the membership, as may be approved by the Senate.

DURATION OF THE COURSE

The courses would normally be conducted part-time basis during the weekend.

Those who complete 60 credits, including a 20-credit research project, will be eligible for a Masters Degree with Coursework and Research Component (MSc in). Postgraduate Diplomas are available as a fallback option for those who complete credits.
