University of Moratuwa will entertain applications for the undermentioned posts from suitably qualified persons.

01 Post of Technical Officer (ICT) Grade III

- Qualifications:**
- (I) Should have passed in three (03) subjects at the G.C.E. (Advanced Level) examination in one (01) sitting in any Stream.
- AND**
- (II) Having obtained a certificate of proficiency not below than the N.V.Q. Level 5 issued by a Technical/ Vocational Training Institute accepted by the Tertiary and Vocational Education Commission or recognized Institution in the field of Information Communication and Multimedia Technology/ Information and Communication Technology/ Information Technology or Equivalent.

Remarks: Preference will be given for those who have work experience in ICT.

Age: Should be not less than 18 years and not more than 45 years.

Salary Scale: U-MT I (III) Rs. 51,095 – 7x540; 10x640 – 60,575 p.m.
Salary will be paid in accordance with Management Services Circular No. 06/2025 and University Grant Commission Circular No. 02/2025 (i)

Method of Selection: By written and/ or practical test and an interview.

Preference will be given for those who have work experience in ICT.

02. Post of Public Health Inspector (Grade III)

Qualifications: Should have passed the Public Health Inspectors Examination conducted by the Department of Health.

Age: Not more than 45 years.

Salary Scale: U-MT 1 (III) Rs. 51,095-7x540; 10x640 - 60,575 p.m.
Salary will be paid in accordance with Management Services Circular No. 06/2025 and University Grant Commission Circular No. 02/2025 (i)

Method of Selection: - By an Interview.

03. Post of Technical Officer (Grade II) Seg "B"

Qualifications: (a) Three (03) G.E.C. (Advanced Level) Passes in Science subjects in one sitting; Subject combination (s) to be decided by the faculty concerned upon the recommendation of the Department.

AND

(b) Passed a skill oriented formal Programme of training relevant to the post of least one year (full-time) duration or equivalent. The acceptability of the training program for this purpose shall be judged by the faculty concerned.

Appointment under "Segment B" of the Technical Officers' service will be as "Trainee Technical Officer" for a period of 3 years. At the conclusion of training those who have gained competence in Laboratory techniques, indenting, maintenance of inventories and ability to type in English will be confirmed and appointment made to permanent posts of "Technical Officer Grade II - Segment B".

Age: Not more than 35 years.

Salary Scale: U-MT I (III) Rs. 51,095 - 7x540; 10x640 - 60,575 p.m.
Salary will be paid in accordance with Management Services Circular No. 06/2025 and University Grant Commission Circular No. 02/2025 (i)

Method of Selection: By a practical test and an interview.

04. Post of Driver (Grade III)

Qualifications: 1. Having passed six (06) subjects in G.C.E. (O/L) examination, at least with two (02) credit passes in maximum of two sittings.

AND

2. Having obtained the license issued by the Commissioner General of Motor Traffic for driving heavy vehicles and a minimum of three (03) years experience in driving after obtaining the driving license.

Age: Should be not less than 18 years and not more than 45 years.

Other:-

1. Should be a citizen of Sri Lanka.
2. Should be physically and mentally fit to the discharge the duties of the post well and to serve in any part of the island.
3. Should be of excellent moral character.

The applicant should submit a police report obtained recently along with the application.

Salary Scale: U-PL 3 (III) Rs. 48,005-16x490-55,845 p.m.
Salary will be paid in accordance with Management Services Circular No. 06/2025 and University Grant Commission Circular No. 02/2025 (i)

Method of Selection: - By Trade Test and a Structured Interview.

05. Post of Tractor Operator (Grade III)

Qualifications: (i) Should have passed the G.C.E (O/L) Examination in six (06) subjects with at least two (02) credit passes in not more than two sittings and having obtained a proficiency certificate not below than the National Vocational Qualifications (NVQ) Level 2 or 3, issued by a Technical/Vocational training institute accepted by the Tertiary and Vocational Education Commission, relevant to the function of each post.

OR

(ii) Should have passed the G.C.E. (O/L) Examination in six (06) subjects with at least two (02) credit passes in not more than two sittings and one (01) year working experience in a relevant field with industrial skills.

Age: Should be not less than 18 years and not more than 45 years.

Other:-

1. Should be a citizen of Sri Lanka.
2. Should be physically and mentally fit to the discharge the duties of the post well and to serve in any part of the island.
3. Should be of excellent moral character.

The applicant should at least possess a valid driving license of G1 category issued by the Commissioner General of Motor Traffic.

Salary Scale: U-PL 2 (III) Rs. 44,575-16x490-52,415 p.m.
Salary will be paid in accordance with Management Services Circular No. 06/2025 and University Grant Commission Circular No. 02/2025 (i)

Method of Selection: - By Trade Test and a Structured Interview.

** In addition to the basic salary, the cost of living allowance and other approved allowances will be paid to the selected candidate/s.
