Academic achievement</b>	135 points	50 points	<p><b>1.1</b> 1 point for every 0.02 exceeding overall GPA beyond 3.7</p> <p><b>1.2</b> 10 points for having the best overall GPA in the respective Degree Program</p> <p><b>1.3</b> Normalized points for Dean's list awards – up to a max. 32 points (No. of Dean's list awards/Total No. of applicable Semesters for Dean's list*32)</p> <p><b>1.4</b> Up to 6 points for the best performance in the final individual project (research/design) within the Degree Program</p> <p><b>1.5</b> 6 points each for International and 3 points each for national level academic related competitive awards. (Depending on the level of achievement evaluated above max. 30 points)</p> <p><b>1.6</b> Academic presentations and publications: Up to 3 points each for presentations and up to 6 points each for publications (Depending on the type, up to a max. 30 points).</p> <p><b>1.7</b> Up to 3 points each for department level awards for academic achievements awarded at the University Award Ceremony (Maximum 9)</p>

Leadership, interpersonal skills &amp; extra-curricular activities</b>	150 points	40 points	<p>In a recognized University body or national/professional body</p> <p><b>2.1</b> Up to 5 points each for President or Secretary or Captain or similar top management role (Depending on the level, max. 12 points)</p> <p><b>2.2</b> Up to 3 points each for other office bearer or Vice-Captain or Coordinator or similar position (Depending on the level, max. 9 points)</p> <p><b>2.3</b> Up to 2 points each for active committee membership (Depending on the level, max. 4 points)</p> <p><b>2.4</b> Up to 2 points each for a leadership role in a major activity (max 4 points)</p> <p><b>2.5</b> Up to 5 points for SLUSA colours and up to 4 points for each university colours award (max. 20 points)</p> <p><b>2.6</b> Up to 10 points for winners (1st, 2nd and 3rd places) at National level sports event) (max. 20 points)</p> <p><b>2.7</b> Up to 20 points for each International level representation at sports (e.g.: World University Games, Olympic games, member of a National sports team)</p> <p><b>2.8</b> Up to 5 points for SLUSA special awards and up to 4 points for each university special award (max. 20 points)</p> <p><b>2.9</b> Up to 8 points for each National level award (max. 16 points)</p> <p><b>2.10</b> Up to 10 points for each International level award (max. 20 points)</p> <p><b>2.11</b> 2 points each for taking part in dramas, debates, and other similar activities (max. 10 points)</p> <p><b>2.12</b> 3 points each for community service / voluntary work (max. 9 points)</p> <p><b>2.13</b> Up to 3 points each for creative work/art and craft (max 12 points)</p> <p><b>2.14</b> Up to 2 points each for publications not covered under academic achievement (max. 6 points)</p>

			<p><b>2.15</b> Up to 3 points each for awards related to extracurricular activities not covered above (max. 9 points)</p> <p><b>2.16</b> Up to 5 points may be allocated by the panel of Evaluators for activities not explicitly listed above.</p> <p>(Note: a maximum of 15 points may be accumulated, even in different years, for a single extracurricular activity.)</p>
<b>3. Essay and Presentation/ Interview</b>	15 points	10 points	<p>Evaluated by the Panel of Evaluators based on:</p> <p><b>3.1</b> An essay submitted (marked up to 5 points) and</p> <p><b>3.2</b> A presentation made at the interview (marked up to 10 points).</p>
