## <u>Vidya Jyothi Professor Dayantha S Wijeyesekera Award for the Most Outstanding Graduate of the Year</u>

## **Selection Procedure and Criteria**

The selection of the award winner will be made by a Panel of Evaluators appointed by the University Senate and based on a point scheme. Short-listed applicants will be invited by the Panel of Evaluators to make a presentation.
